## **FISCAL YEAR 2020 ANNUAL REPORT**

### FY 2020 Highlights

- We all faced unprecedented challenges because of the COVID-19 pandemic and the Jefferson County Prevention and Recovery Board was no exception. Many programs and initiatives were delayed or put on hold due to the pandemic. However, we were able to work quickly to assist with local challenges.
  - Worked closely with local providers to navigate the state and federal rules around telehealth.
  - Implemented a media campaign to ensure that the community was aware that services remained available during the pandemic.
  - Distributed over 100,000 masks to our local providers.
- Continued the Federally funded State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant; SOR supports EOCC and Family Recovery Center to increase availability of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT).
- Contracted with the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) to provide support groups for residents of Jefferson County experiencing stress or anxiety due to COVID.
- Ongoing support of all Jefferson County school districts through grants and the evidence-based PAX Program in partnership with the Jefferson County Educational Service Center (JCESC).
- Although delayed by COVID, the Crisis Stabilization Unit located at Trinity West, continued to be developed and is awaiting final licensure by the State.
- In Partnership with the JCESC and Union County Mental Health & Recovery Board, continued the Engage programming serving youth and their families through funding from the Strong Families, Safe Communities Grant.
- Continued support of Judge Mascio's specialty docket, Mental Health Court, through Municipal Court.
- Supported the United Prevention Partnership in applying for the Federal Drug Free Communities grant.
- Participated in the Week of Appreciation, recognizing the hard work and sacrifice of front-line behavioral health workers during the pandemic.

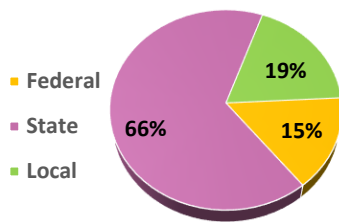

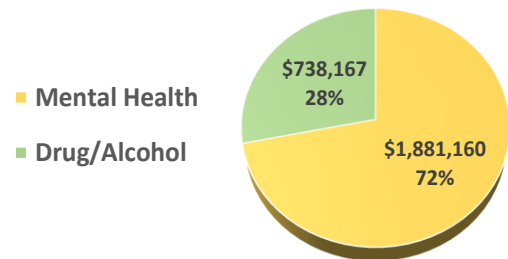

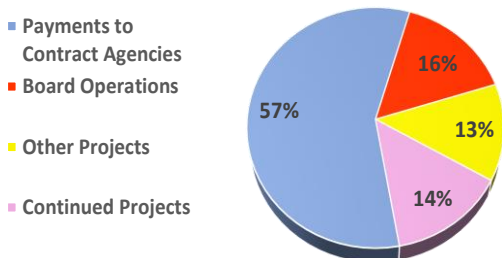


**Services Provided**

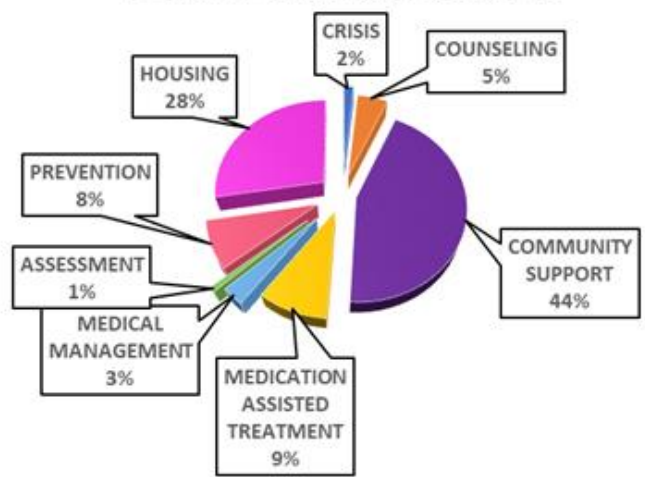
